Subsequently, one of the subscribers, who identified himself as "John Doe," filed 1 2 objections to a Rule 45 subpoena issued pursuant to this court's expedited discovery order and 3 served on one of the ISPs, Charter Communications, Inc. (See Letter dated March 10, 2012.) Even if this court were to construe the objections as a motion to quash or modify the subpoena, it 4 5 appears that the subpoena was issued out of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois. Accordingly, any motion to quash or modify the subpoena must be filed in 6 7 that court, in accordance with its local rules and the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.¹ Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT: 8 9 1. Third party John Doe's objections, construed as a purported motion to quash 10 the subpoena, are denied without prejudice. 11 2.
